Raffle time	<p>The raffle starts on the first day of Term 2, Tuesday 18th April 2017 and closes on Thursday 21 September 2017.</p> <p>The raffle will be drawn 9:00am on the last day of Term 3, Friday 22nd September 2017 at Gippsland Grammar School, Garnsey Campus.</p>
Winning entry	The winning entry will be randomly drawn in the presence of two members of the Old Scholars Association Executive Committee and one member of the Gippsland Grammar School Executive Team
Valid ticket	A valid ticket will include the purchasers name and contact details. Raffle tickets will be entered into the draw when the whole payment is received. Raffle tickets must include the name of the student who is nominated to benefit from the prize, or the wording 'Principal's Choice' (see below). The winning ticket is not transferrable. The raffle ticket number will be printed on the official receipt.
Persons ineligible to purchase tickets	Office holders & relatives of office holders of the Old Scholars Association Executive Committee; the Gippsland Grammar School Business Manager and the Gippsland Grammar School Development Officer, are ineligible to purchase tickets for themselves or on behalf of any other person.
Principal's choice	A valid ticket must include the name of the student who is nominated to benefit from the prize. In lieu of a student's name, entries may include the words ' <i>Principal's choice</i> '. Should the winning entry nominate ' <i>Principal's choice</i> ' then the Principal of Gippsland Grammar School will select a student based on existing bursary criteria.
